Description

The Reinhart-Cabinett is within Hof's historic Hospital Building, directly opposite the Bayerisches Vogtland Museum. Named after Johann Christian Reinhart (1761-1847), it was opened in January 2008. This great son of the town of Hof spent most of his life in Rome and made a name for himself as a neo-classical landscape painter. In 1839 he was appointed court painter to the Bavarian royal family by King Ludwig 1.

Hof's collection of works by this Germano-Roman painter consists of 131 pictures, of which 33 are to be seen in rotation in the Reinhart-Cabinett. Besides this, the Kulturkreis organizes exhibitions by other local artists every year. Guided tours can be arranged on request.
